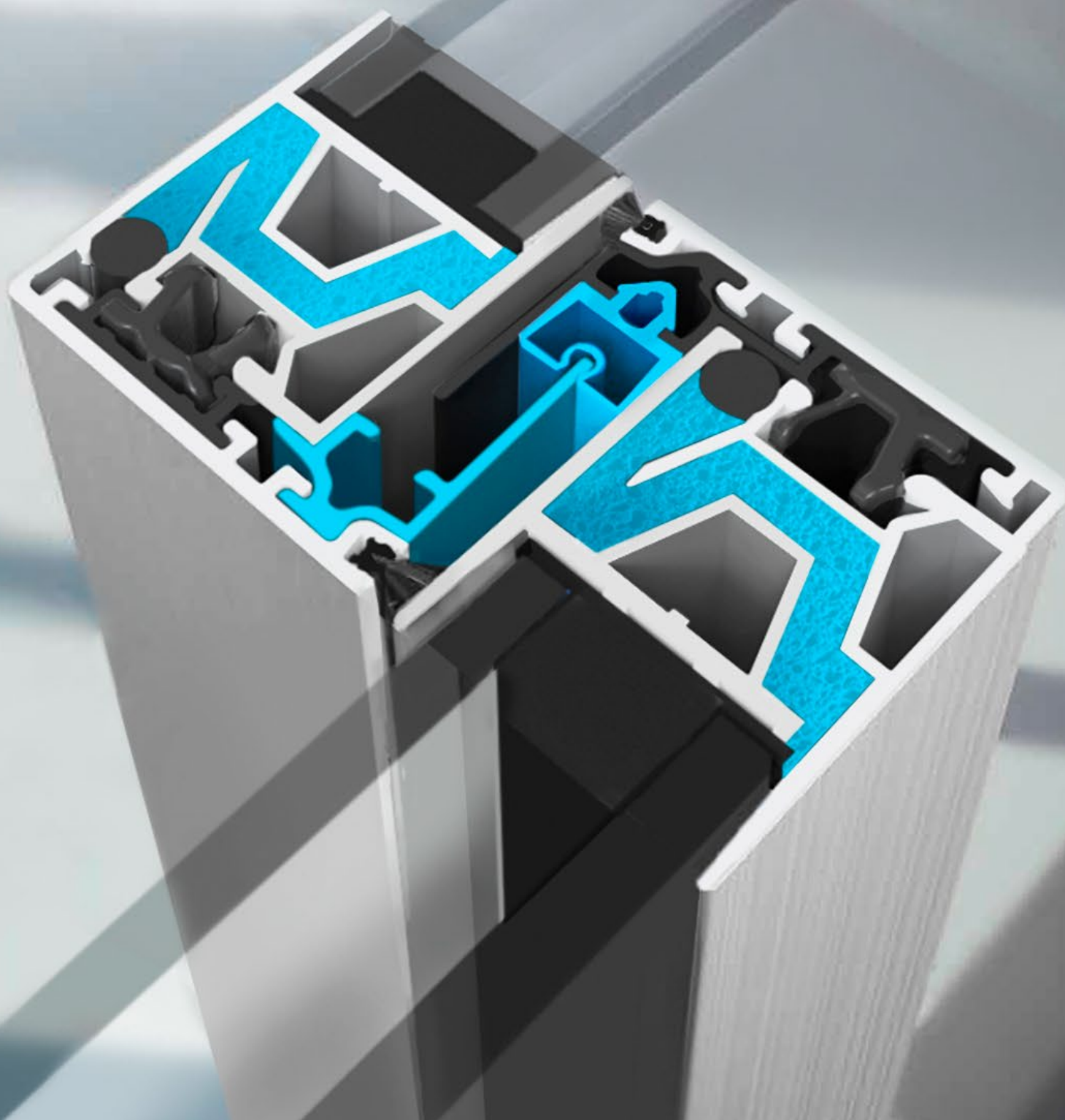

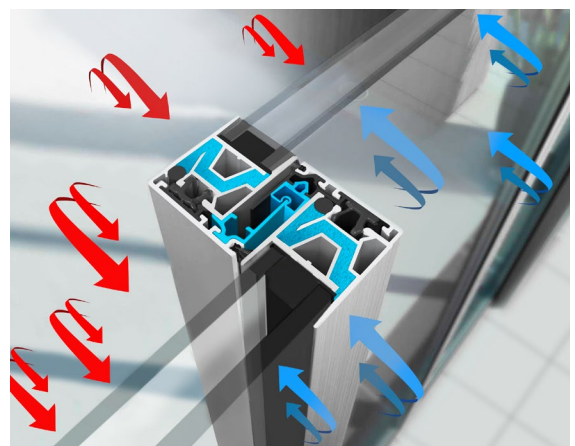


Energy saving

Heat loss via walls and doors can be efficiently reduced by the automatic door system THERMCORD³ with complete thermal separation, from the panel and profile system to the thermally separated floor rail in the longitudinal axis.

- Triple glazing to improve thermal insulation
- Unchanged series drives – therefore economical in maintenance and servicing

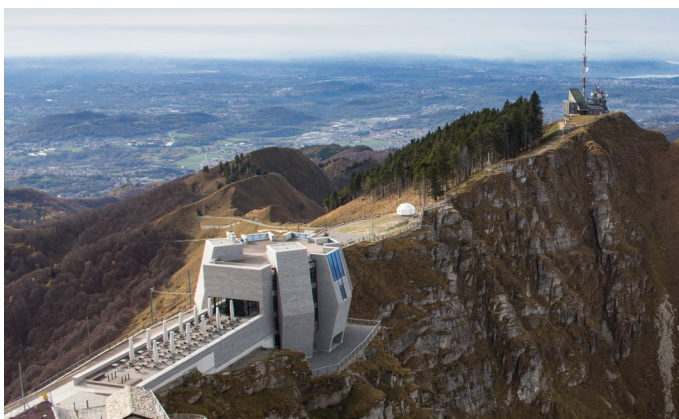
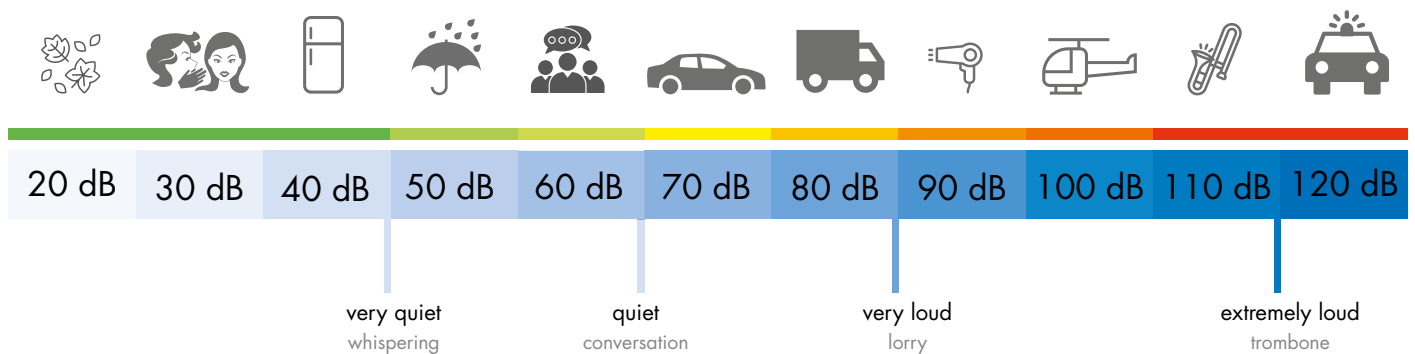
Weather-Resistant

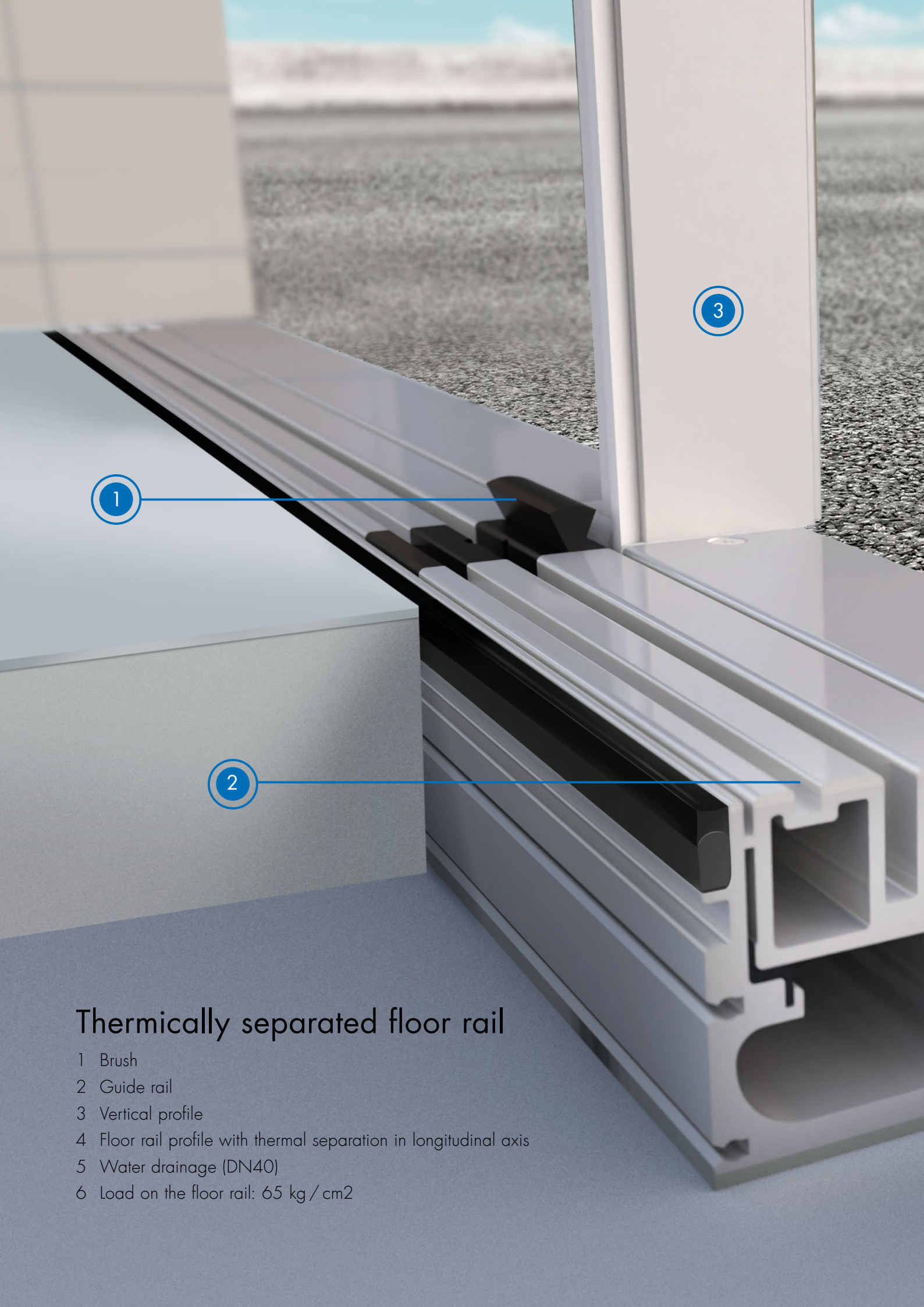
The longitudinal profiles installed in the door leaves feature enormous rigidity with their structure-reinforcing double V-shape. This means that the movement of the door is largely unaffected by high wind loads, suction or pressure. As a further result of this rigidity, the clearances could be reduced, which in terms of avoiding draughts makes the THERMCORD³ superior to a conventional design already in the layout. Even driving rain with an intensity far exceeding the maximum defined category E 600,A is effectively repelled and protects your entrance area from weather damage.

Noise Reduction

Thermal separation can also be used for acoustic separation and therefore have sound-insulating properties. Direct airborne sound insulation value 35 dB – quietness when quietness is required.





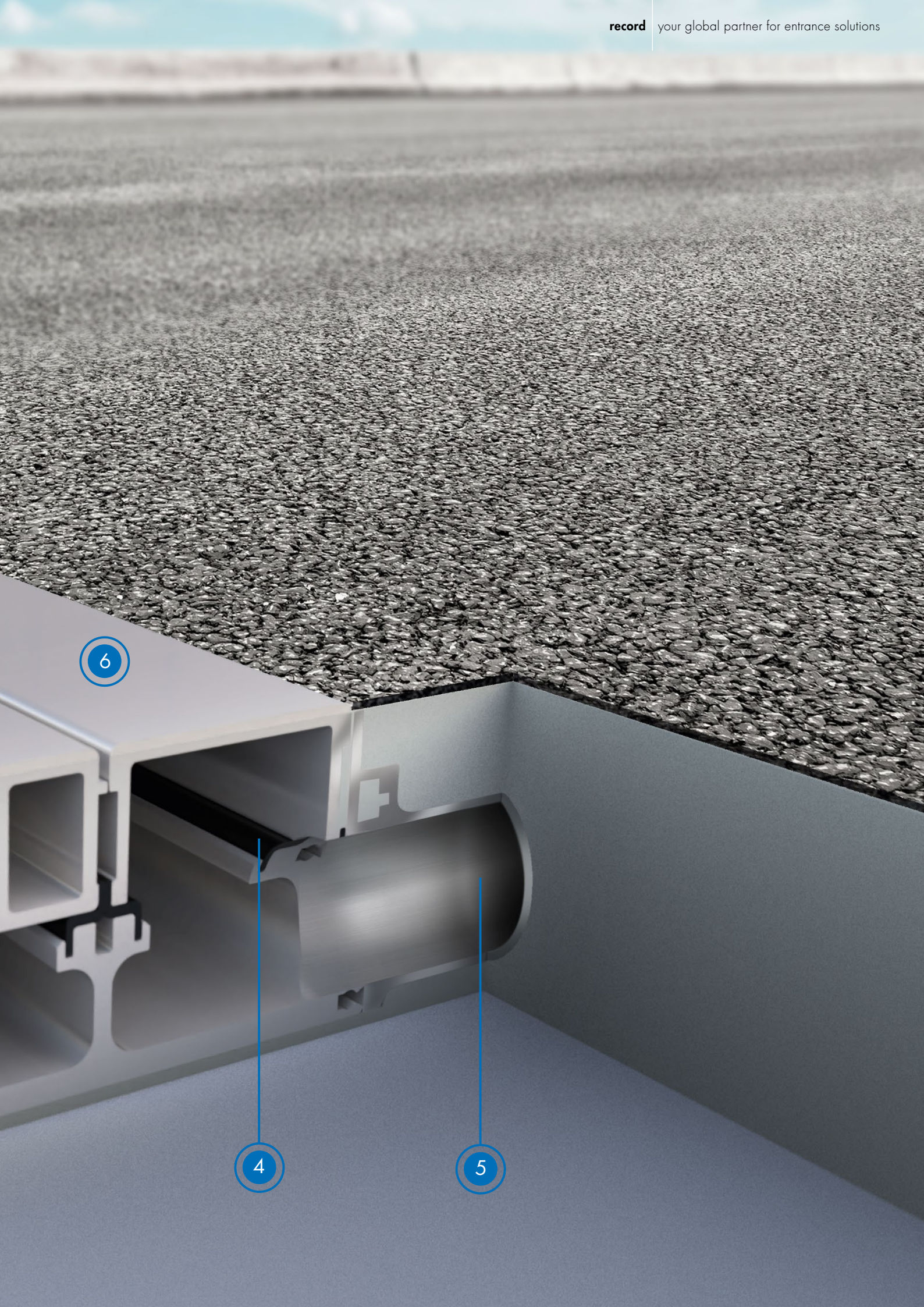

- Installation of the drive, door leaf and also commissioning.

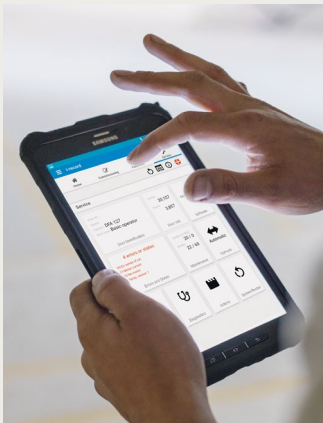
